Requirements:

- Be willing to engage, be active, listen, debate, and be respectful of others and their opinions
- Proficiency in conversational English, not perfect English, just able to use English

Expectations:

- Attend monthly Youth Council meetings and participate in member-led activities for one year
- Share what you are learning with your peers
- Represent the Youth Council at occasional events
